ICMA News - Membership

As you are aware, the Board strategic planning in December 2019 identified the dues structure and value of membership as a key strategic priority for the organization.

We are happy to report that changes are being made for the next fiscal year! ICMA is retaining the

salary-based approach; however, the salary adjuster has been decreased from .008 to .0065 AND the cap has been decreased from \$1400 to \$1200.

Also, a small community with a population with less than 7,500 and a budget less than \$7.8 million will receive an additional 20% discount.

Lastly, the Board also voted to retain the discounted, flat rate dues structure for entry level through department head professionals.
