




- Populations in communities with college dorms, jails or barracks were often miscounted in 2020
- Low response rates in 2020 caused the Census Bureau to impute many results
- Nearly all 2020 Census data was distorted to protect respondents privacy
- In 2020, the Census Bureau significantly changed how it counted and tabulated racial/ethnic groups




Some communities were miscounted in 2020








1990-2020






Population that identifies as Black

1990-2020






Population that identifies as Asian 1990-2020










The shift to outmigration has slowed growth in Virginia










Virginia total annual births and deaths






Population Change: 2010s












Percent change by age group










Median Age: 1980












Center of Population for Virginia, **1940**








Center of Population for Virginia

Percent Change in Population 1900 to 1910














Percent Working from Home: 2019






The top metro areas for telecommuting are typically in areas with access to outdoor recreation






Even before the Pandemic, Americans preferred low density areas






Change in Addresses from Migration: 2019






Change in Addresses from Migration: 2021
